

Boso-no-Mura is an interactive museum. Step inside and travel back in time to the Edo period (about 300 years ago)! The museum organizes about 350 events and courses annually including tea ceremony, candle-making or coaster-making from *tatami* mats and more. Kamogawa Maiwai-zome (fabric dyeing), Suzusen

鴫川蒕祝染 鈴染

The fishing industry has long flourished along the coast of the Boso Peninsula. During the Edo period (1603-1868) the culture of Maiwai (festive Kimonos to celebrate a good catch) developed among the fisherman who lived by the sea in this area. Originally Maiwai meant just celebrating a good catch, but over time it came to mean the kimonos that ship owners would distribute to fishermen for celebration of an especially good catch. You can learn about the dyeing process of Maiwai making. Put your favorite colors on the cloth!

Little Edo Sawara Boat Trip 小江戸さわら舟めぐり



During the Edo period, houses of merchants and traders lined the streets along both sides of the Ono River and the surrounding area. Even now, the historical scenery of this once commercially prosperous town remains. Enjoy an Ono River sightseeing boat-riding tour for about 30 minutes.

You can enjoy Sawara full of Edo period atmosphere from the boat.

Shakyo (sutra copying) at Naritasan Shinsho-ji Temple 写経体験 成田山新勝寺

At Naritasan Shinsho-ji Temple, you can try a spiritual practice called "shakyo (sutra copying)," in which you copy sutras with a calm mind. By concentrating on carefully copying sutras, it is said to have a refreshing effect on your body and soul. The practice is made easier for beginners, for example, by providing a chair instead of making you sit on your legs on the floor and providing a paper which makes it easier to copy sutras. You can take the ink brush you used for copying sutras back with you as a souvenir.

Mt. Nokogiriyama Hiking

1 鋸山ハイキング

Standing on the west coast of the Boso Peninsula, Mt. Nokogiriyama has an altitude of 329 meters. There is a ropeway service, but it takes only about one hour on foot to the peak and it is a great casual hiking course. This area has long been a producer of high-quality

stones, so you can see geometric patterns on the quay wall close-up. The curious sight is just like one you would see in a Ghibli studio movie.

There is a temple, Nihon-ji Temple, on the south side of the mountain. It is home to a large stone Buddha statue, and you can also see Mt. Fuji from the observatory on clear days.

Kasamori-Kannon Temple Hiking


Kasamori-Kannon Temple, founded in 784, is surrounded by mountains which have been designated as a prefectural nature park. A trail runs behind the temple ideal for trekking and hiking. From the observatory in the middle of the trail, you can see Mt. Fuji on clear days. 3-4 hours is usually sufficient to enjoy Kasamori-Kannon and the surroundings.

Showa no Mori Park Cycling Course





Showa no Mori is one of Japan's most famous parks, which was selected as one of the "100 Urban Parks in Japan." The park contains athletic courses, camping sites, tennis courts, ball game grounds, an observatory, a botanical garden, and ruins, as well as 2 cycling courses for bicycles only. The outer course is 3.5 km and the inner course is 1.6 km. There is a bicycle rental service in the park. There are 130 bicycles available at the Dai-ichi (no. 1) Cycling Center (open only on Sundays and holidays) and 140 bicycles at the Dai-ini (no. 2) Cycling Center. You can rent a bicycle of a size from 20 inch to 26 inch. The rental fees are 200 yen for adults and 100 yen for junior high school and elementary school students, both for 2 hours. The bicycles are available from 9am to 4pm, with the rental counter open from 9am to 3pm. You can also enjoy riding your own bicycle if you bring one with you.



Chiba Urban Monorail

千葉都市モノレール

This two-line suspended monorail system is very rare in the world and makes you feel like you are on a flying train. It was recorded in the Guinness World Record for the world's longest running distance of suspended monorail (15.2 km of track) in 2001. The new train cars have an improved view with glass in part of the floor, making you feel like you are flying as well as being thrilled. Don't miss it if you are visiting the <u>Bay area</u>.

This hands-on event allows you to drive a go-kart on public roads in Minamiboso. With an instructor leading the tour, you can drive safely even if you have never driven a go-kart. Enjoy cycling!



With only small differences in altitude and a mild climate with warm winters, Chiba Prefecture is a place where you can enjoy cycling all year round. By bicycle, your sightseeing tour will be more efficient and you can feel a nice breeze that you wouldn't feel by walking. You may also find something you would never notice on a train or bus.

If you are a beginner cyclist, you may want to go around the historical areas, such as Sakura and Sawara, by rental bicycle (for details, go to pages 39 and 40). If you want to explore more, you can try the course along the ocean in Minamiboso. Some rental bicycle places also have electric bicycles.



Bring your bicycle to Boso! B. B. BASE

If you want to enjoy cycling around on your bicycle in Chiba, you should take "B.B.BASE," a special train for cyclists from Tokyo to Chiba. Leaving JR Ryogoku Station, this train stops at several stations all over Chiba. After enjoying cycling, take "B.B.BASE" again back to Tokyo in the evening. You can enjoy a carefree cycling tour in a day trip or an overnight trip.

At the bicycle station next to JR Ryogoku Station, a rental service of road bikes and cross bikes is available. So even if you don't have your own bicycle, you can rent a favorite bike and get on "B.B.BASE."



Hot Springs

There are many popular hot springs on the Boso Peninsula in Chiba which are easily accessible from Tokyo. Enjoy Chiba's hot springs in an open-air bath with a panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean or a traditional famous ryokan (traditional Japanese inn).

Shirahama Ocean Resort

You can have a panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean from the large bath filled with natural hot spring water. The spring water is odor-less and taste-less containing metasilicate, which makes your body warm and improves the bloodstream so that you can recover from physical and mental exhaustion in a relaxing atmosphere.



Inubohsaki Hotel with a Grand View

The bath is filled with natural hot spring coming from 1,300 meters below ground from the strata before the Cretaceous Period. During the day, you can enjoy the openness of the Pacific Ocean as far as you can see, and at night you can relax while looking at the dreamy light of the Inubo Lighthouse.







Gyokeikan

This ryokan hotel has hosted many famous Japanese politicians and literary figures who were active some 100 years ago, including Ito Hirobumi, the first Prime Minster of Japan, Hideyo Noguchi, Koyo Ozaki, Toson Shimazaki, and Kotaro Takamura. From the big bath which arches out into the Pacific Ocean, you can feel the power of the big ocean spreading in front of you.





Sky garden bath with beautiful sunset

Kichimu

This onsen ryokan hotel offers a wonderful panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean from a "sky garden bath," which is located 35 meters above the ground. You can see the beautiful ocean from six different types of open-



air baths and large baths with unique names and features, such as "Water of Birth," "Water of Vows" and "Water of the Starry Sky," as well as from guestrooms and the lobby. You can enjoy an open-air bath while seeing the beautiful sunset.



Completely 'Wa' -Japanese style-ryokan hotel to enjoy two types of Kamogawa hot springs

KAMOGAWAKAN _{時川館}

You can enjoy two types of hot spring water with different compositions, including "Shiosai-no-yu" at the large bath, which is from the ocean, and "Nagisa-no-yu" at the rooftop onsen pool (in a swimsuit) with a panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean, which is from the mountains. The hotel also has several unique open-air baths, including a Jacuzzi, waterfall bath, and hinoki (cypress-wood) bath.

Spa & Resort Kujukuri Taiyo-no-Sato Հ۲&Սゾートカキカ里 太陽の里

One of the main features of this accommodation facility is an open-air bath with natural hot spring water. It is equipped with various relaxation facilities, including a hot stone spa facility with one of the biggest areas in the prefecture, an esthetic salon, and a body-care salon. At the large hall in the main building, you can enjoy watching a performance of stage entertainment by a theater troupe.

Animals

Chiba Prefecture has one of the major farms in Japan and one of the major aquariums in Japan, as well as the zoo with the greatest number of elephants in Japan and popular lesser pandas. The following section introduces 4 popular spots where you can enjoy touching animals.

Mother Farm

Located on Mt. Kano, which offers a grand panoramic view of the mountains on Boso Peninsula, Tokyo Bay, and Mt. Fuji, Mother Farm is one of the biggest tourist ranches in the Kanto area. On the huge grounds of about 2.5 million square meters, seasonal flowers are beautifully blossoming and various animals, including alpacas, cows, sheep, horses, and goats, are available for visitors to play with and touch. There are lots of activities, including horse-back riding, zip line, bungee jumping, an amusement park, strawberry and blueberry picking, and hand-making experiences, providing an entertaining farm where both grownups and children can have fun.

Ichihara Elephant Kingdom

Located roughly in the center of Chiba Prefecture, this zoo has 12 elephants, which is the greatest number in Japan, along with about 90 kinds of animals, including capybaras and hippos. The popular "Elephant Show," where elephants perform difficult tasks, such as playing soccer and dancing, is offered almost every day. There are also various attractions, such as "Elephant Riding," where you can get on the back of an elephant, "Elephant Lift," where you can hang down from the nose of an elephant, and photo taking with a small elephant.

Sammu is a city famous for its strawberries. Along Route 126 and Prefectural roads 76 and 121, there are so many strawberry farms one next to the other that people call that area "Strawberry Road"! It is also easily accessible. It takes about 40 minutes by car to get from Narita International Airport to the nearest highway interchange, the Sanbu-Naruto Interchange.


At the Sammusubi (Naruto Station Tourist Information Center), immediately on the left as you exit the Naruto Station on the JR Sobu Line, you can find information about all the strawberry farms that are members of the association. These are not only places where you can go to pick strawberries. Some of them also sell handmade jam or strawberry *daifuku* (Japanese sweets) featuring their delightful produce.
