As rail networks extend in a radial manner from Tokyo there is a particularly rich number of railways in the north-west of the prefecture. With express trains and other means available it is possible to reach the south of the Boso area more quickly than you would imagine.


[How to use taxis] Japanese taxi is a safe transportation means. There are taxi ranks at most railway stations. Pay onboard after reaching your destination. Base fare is 500 yen for 1.27km. After this fares are calculated based on time and distance. Fares between 22:00 and 5:00 have a 20% surcharge. No tip is necessary. When using taxis from sightseeing spots, you can call the number on the receipt you received on the journey there and the staff at the spot will call a taxi for you. Depending on the spot it may also be possible to hail a passing taxi.



For locations which are not easily reached by rail, you can use a highway bus. The ease of being able to reach your destination mainly using expressways without having to change trains.

As there are around 5kms between Sawara Station and Katori-jingu Shrine, use of a taxi is recommended. The Sawara loop bus operates on Sat., Sun., and public holidays. 300 yen or one-day boarding pass 600 yen. One to two buses per hour. It is possible to cover Sawara on foot.


Visit the noted temples which receive the most pilgirms in Chiba to walk a townscape which could only be found in a temple district.







A temple district a mere 10 minutes train ride from Narita International Airport. The approach all the way from the station to Naritasan Shinshoii Temple provides ample Japanese atmosphere, and the walk is enjoyable in and of itself. Narita-san Park located on the grounds is famous for its flowers. Plum and cherry blossoms, wisteria and chrysanthemums are among the flowers that can be seen throughout the seasons.
