Sakura City, the castle town of the Sakura domain during the Edo period (1603-1868), is a trove of castle ruins and former samurai residences. Held here is a walking tour in which you can explore the castle town as if you were a samurai of the past. Along with a tour that is available in English, you can also enjoy various experiences such as exploring the ruins and taking pictures in a samurai costume and practicing martial arts with a bamboo sword.

Early July

Narita Gion Festival

成田祇園祭

Around Naritasan Shinsho-ji Temple

Roughly 450,000 spectators come to enjoy this festival with over 300 years of history every year. It is a big summer event in which ten floats and stalls and a mikoshi (portable shrine) adorned with splendid sculptures and decorations are carried out for a three-day procession through Naritasan Omotesando Street and the surrounding area.

Mt. Nokogiri Hiking

鷲山ハイキング

At 329 meters high, Mt. Nokogiri first gained fame as a stone quarry during the Edo period (1603-1867). Even today, you can find exposed cliff faces and remnants of the stone quarry throughout the mountain. It is also a popular hiking course with many notable features. The north side offers both breathtaking and unusual views and vistas, while the south side is home to Nihonji Temple with its many stone Buddha statues.

To reach the Sancho Station Observatory, you can take the Mt. Nokogiri Ropeway. If you are using a car, take the toll road to get nearby. *The summit of Mt. Nokogiri and the Mt. Nokogiri Ropeway Sancho Station are two different locations.

While hiking, you can see a stone Kannon statue approximately 30 meters tall, carved into the vertical wall of the quarry.



Another must-see is the 31-meter Buddha statue in Nihonji Temple carved directly into the rock, one of the biggest of its kind in Japan.

Let's enjoy various types of trains in Chiba

Train Experience

In Chiba Prefecture, various trains are in service, including retro-flavored local trains, trains with a great view of beautiful blossoms, and a monorail to enjoy an aerial walk. We will introduce you the trains which will make your trip more fun and enjoyable!



Kominato Railway

小湊鉄道

In Chiba, there are many spots to enjoy beautiful seasonal views. One of the most famous spots among those is the area along the Kominato Railway Line. Started in 1925, this non-electrified single-track line connects a total of 18 stations, from Goi Station, which is located about 20 minutes from JR Chiba Station, to Kazusa Nakano Station. The retro buildings over 100 years old, including a station building and an electricity plant, are still standing along the line, making us feel as if we are back in time in old Japan.



Isumi Railway

いすみ鉄道

Serving as one of the major local railway lines in Chiba Prefecture, Isumi Railway Line connects 14 stations from Ohara Station in Isumi City located in the south part of the Boso Peninsula, to Kazusa Nakano Station, where the line connects to the Kominato Railway Line. You can travel through the Boso Peninsula while enjoying a tranquil and idyllic landscape. From mid-February to late March, nanohana field mustard flowers, the designated flower of Chiba Prefecture, are fully blooming. Enjoy spring in Japan riding on a train running through the yellow carpet of beautiful blossoms!

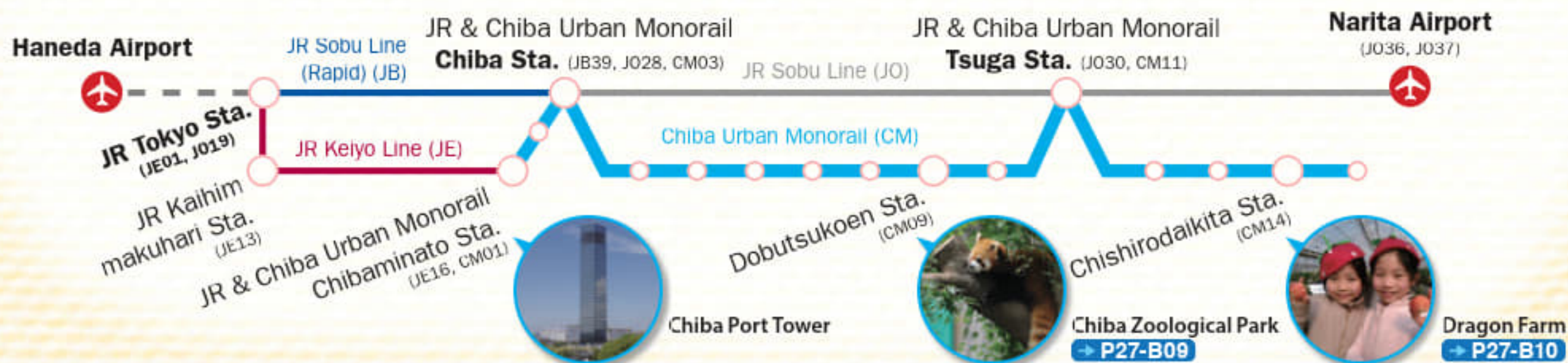

Chiba Urban Monorail

千葉都市モノレール

Running through the tall buildings, this unique suspended monorail makes passengers feel as if they are flying in the sky. It runs for a total of 15.2 km, which is the world's longest distance for a suspended monorail. It has also been listed in the Guinness World Records in 2001. "URBAN FLYER 0-type," the new train car introduced in 2012, uses glass for part of the floor, further expanding a view of passengers. Get on a flying railway line and enjoy an aerial walk in the urban area.



Choshi Electric Rail Line

銚子電鉄

This small local railway line with a total length of 6.4 km has just celebrated its 100th anniversary. Get on a retro-flavored train at Choshi Station in the northeastern part of Chiba Prefecture, run through the urban area, and you will find a sea of cabbages outside the train window. Enjoy a 20-minutes one-way ride on the local line to Tokawa Station with a classic scenery of a fisher town. This railway line faced a risk of being abandoned several times but it was saved by its popular specialty snack "nure-sembei (wet rice crackers)." The unique station nicknames, such as Kaminokekurohae (which literally means "black hair growing") Station and Arigato Station, are also increasing the popularity of this line.



Wakashio Express

わかしお

A limited express connecting Tokyo Station, a gateway to Japan, and Awa-Kamogawa Station, one of the major holiday resorts in the Boso Peninsula in Chiba Prefecture, in about 2 hours. This train stops at some of the major stations, like Katsuura Station, which is located in the port town famous for a morning fair, and Awa-Kominato Station, which is the birthplace of the founder of Nichiren Sect, Nichiren Shonin, and has the head temple of the Nichiren Sect, Tanjo-ji Temple. You can enjoy various scenery along the way, such as the view of urban areas like Tokyo and Makuuari New City, as well as the rich nature like beautiful blue ocean. If you are planning to visit Boso from Tokyo, limited express "Wakashio" will be a great choice of transportation.

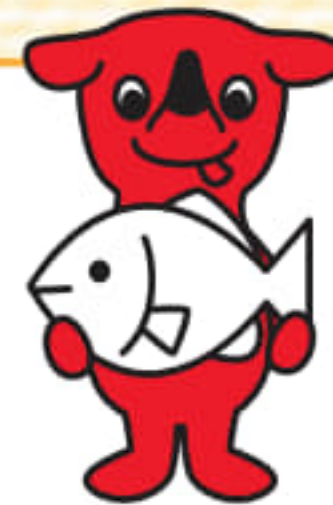




Exquisite Chiba cuisine

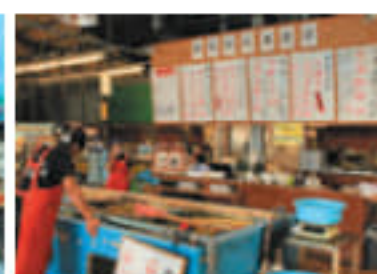

Japanese pears

With Japanese pear cultivation starting here nearly 250 years ago, Chiba has now become the nation's biggest producer of the juicy, sweet fruit.



Melons / Watermelons

Chiba boasts the second largest crop of watermelons in Japan and the main producer is Tomisato City. Asahi City is the biggest producer of melons in Chiba Prefecture.



Loquats

In Japan, these biwa (loquats) known under the brand "Boshu Biwa" are popular gifts. You can eat them as they are, but loquat soft-serve ice cream is pure delight. You can also buy loquat jelly as a souvenir.



CHI-BA berries (Strawberry)

Chiba is also an important region for strawberries. Among the numerous varieties, please try Chiba's original "CHI-BA+BERRY" popular for its large size and perfect balance of sweetness and sourness.

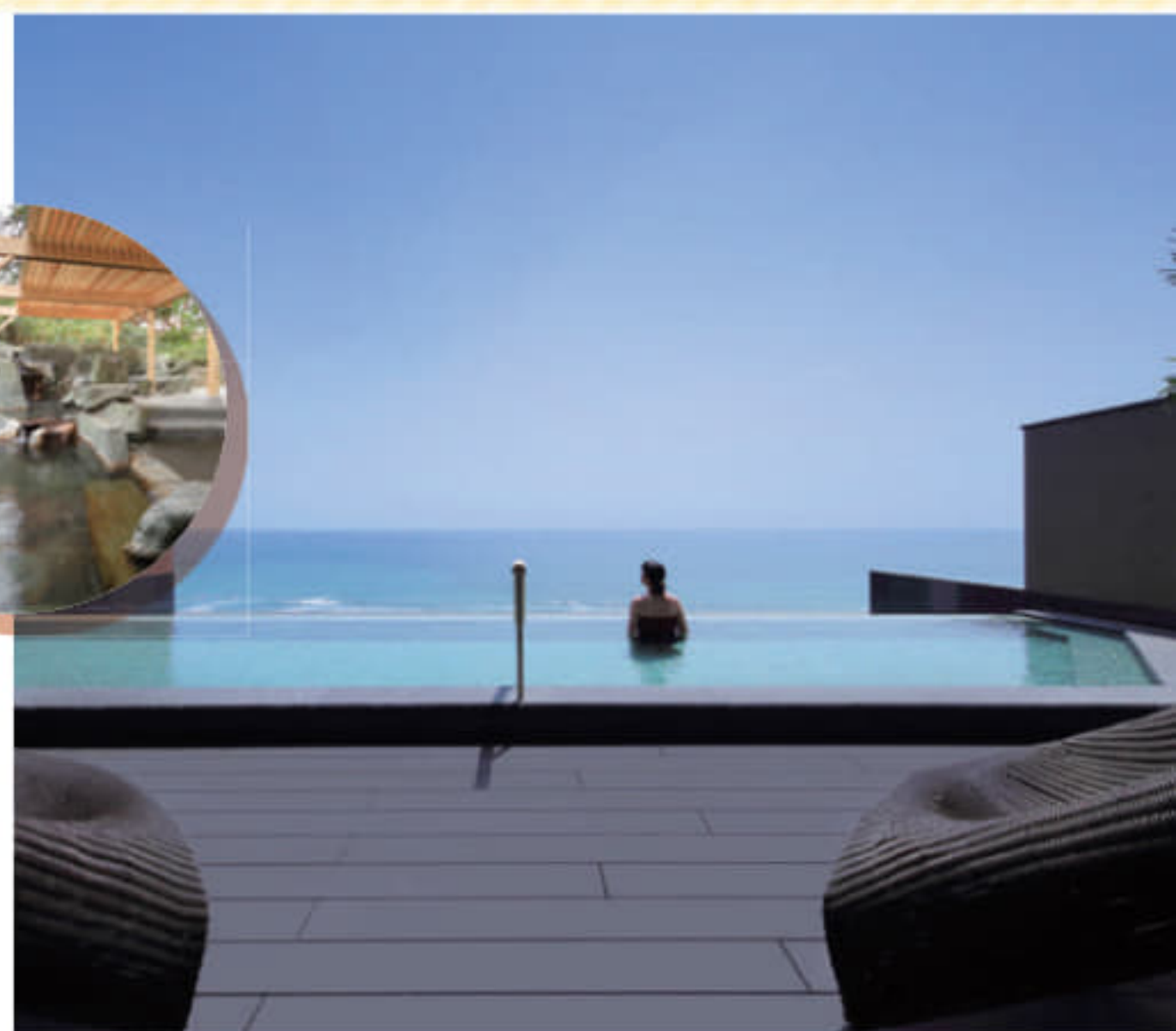

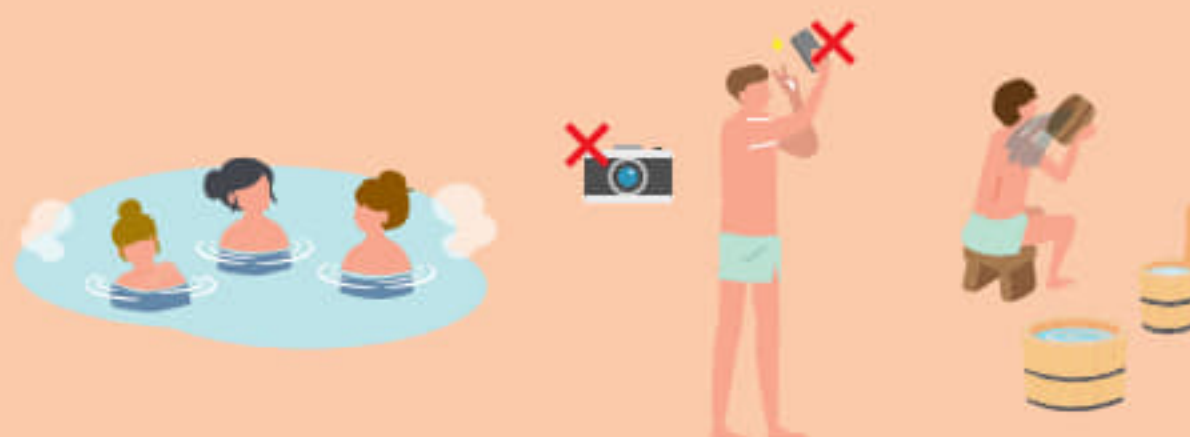

Animals

Chiba Prefecture has one of the major farms in Japan and one of the major aquariums in Japan, as well as the zoo with the greatest number of elephants in Japan and popular lesser pandas. The following section introduces 5 popular spots where you can enjoy touching animals.



Mother Farm

→ P50-S06

マザー牧場

Located on Mt. Kano, which offers a grand panoramic view of the mountains on Boso Peninsula, Tokyo Bay, and Mt. Fuji, Mother Farm is one of the biggest tourist ranches in the Kanto area. On the huge grounds of about 2.5 million square meters, seasonal flowers are beautifully blossoming and various animals, including alpacas, cows, sheep, horses, and goats, are available for visitors to play with and touch. There are lots of activities, including horse-back riding, zip line, bungee jumping, an amusement park, strawberry and blueberry picking, and hand-making experiences, providing an entertaining farm where both grownups and children can have fun.



ICHIHARA ELEPHANT KINGDOM

Located roughly in the center of Chiba Prefecture, this zoo has 12 elephants, which is the greatest number in Japan, along with about 90 kinds of animals, including capybaras and hippos. The popular "Elephant Show," where elephants perform difficult tasks, such as playing soccer and dancing, is offered almost every day. There are also various attractions, such as "Elephant Riding," where you can get on the back of an elephant, "Elephant Lift," where you can hang down from the nose of an elephant, and photo taking with a small elephant.

Inside the pavilion, which is a recreated natural environment, 800 varieties and 11,000 examples of both marine and river animals are kept and it's a great place to learn as well. Around Kamogawa Sea World there are many Japanese style inns and resort facilities to make your stay here a high quality and relaxing one.

Dolphin and Whale Watching at Choshi Ocean Institute

This is a tourist farm located on Mt. Kano that offers a magnificent view of mountains of the Boso Peninsula, Tokyo Bay, and Mt. Fuji. With expansive grounds of 2.5 million square meters, this farm is home to various animals including cows, horses, sheep, and alpacas. It also hosts daily events and shows where visitors can interact with the animals. Popular events include the “Sheep Show” (sheep shearing) at Agrodome and “Cow Milking Experience.” Also popular are the large-scale, picturesque flower gardens with canola flowers in spring as well as petunias, the “momoiro toiki” (pink breath) of summer. Additionally, you can enjoy various other activities including riding the Ferris wheel and bungee jumping from 21 meters high. The souvenir shops sell original Mother Farm sweets and homemade ham and sausages. Some popular park food includes their signature jingisukan mutton dishes and soft-serve ice cream. For seasonal fruit- and vegetable-picking, you can enjoy strawberries, blueberries, sweet potatoes, and more depending on the time of year.

Mt. Nokogiri & Nihonji Temple / Nokogiriyama Ropeway

Mt. Nokogiri is a 329.4-meter-high mountain. The mountain consists of tuff that was suitable for construction and it used to be a quarry from the Edo period. The shape of the exposed mountain surface took on a saw-toothed shape, giving it a name of "Nokogiri," which means "saw." The view from "Jigoku-nozoki," which is situated near the top of the mountain is both beautiful and thrilling. The slope on the south side of the mountain is the temple grounds. The temple, Nihonji was built by the Buddhist monk called Gyoki at the behest of Emperor Shomu about 1,300 years ago. You can visit the largest Buddha statue carved on a rock face with a height of 31 meters, Hyakushaku-Kannon statue, which might remind you of the Bamiyan Buddha and the 1,500 stone figures of Arhats. The ropeway in Mt. Nokogiri is the only ropeway in Chiba Prefecture.

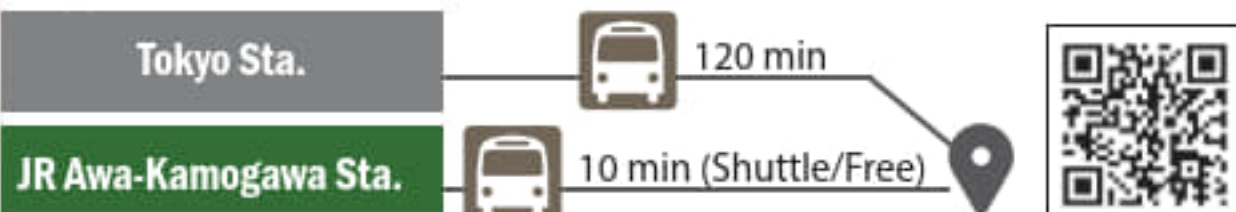
Kamogawa Sea World

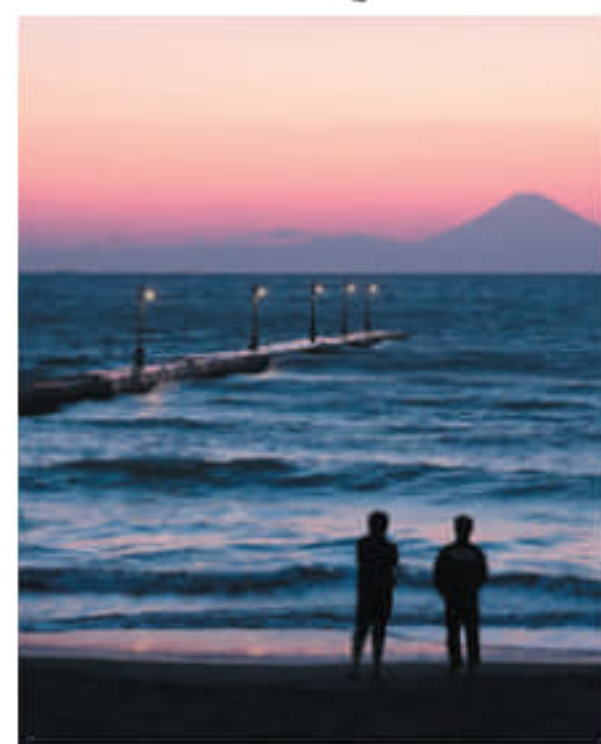

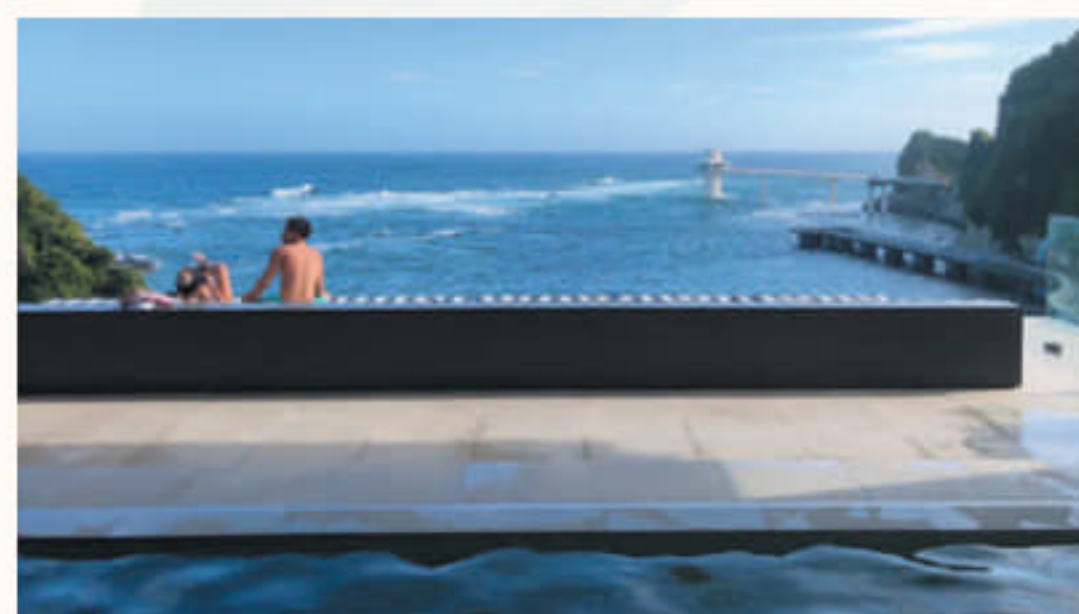

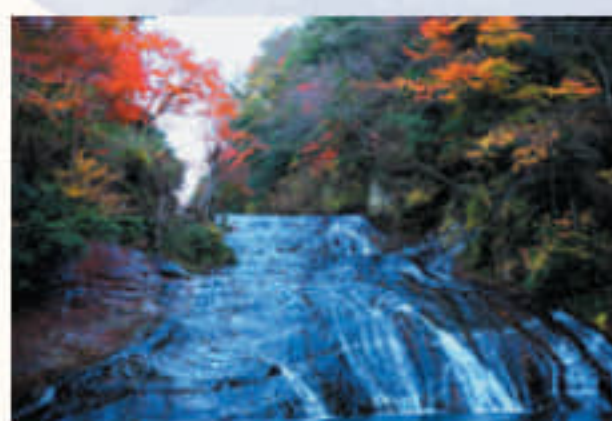

Highways

When driving on highways, having an "ETC card" will allow you to pass through the lane indicated "ETC" at the toll gates. "ETC" is an abbreviation for "Electronic Toll Collection System." With an ETC card inserted into the designated device in your car, the toll fee is automatically deducted, and you do not have to stop at the toll gate. On the other hand, if you do not have an ETC card, you must pay the fee by cash or credit card at the lane indicated with a green "General" sign. ETC cards can be rented from car rental companies (you will be charged with the highway fees when returning your car).

Rental Cars

When you want to use a rental-car service, making a reservation via the website is recommended.

Important Points for Car Rental

- Please be sure to bring your international driver's license and passport.
- Please bring your credit card because in some cases, it is necessary for paying.
- Please be sure to contact the rental shop if you are delayed for the booking or returning time.
- Please return the car with a full tank of gas.

GPS Navigation

Car navigation systems are usually installed in cars at many rental-car services. In some systems, you can change the display into the English version. For details, contact the staff.

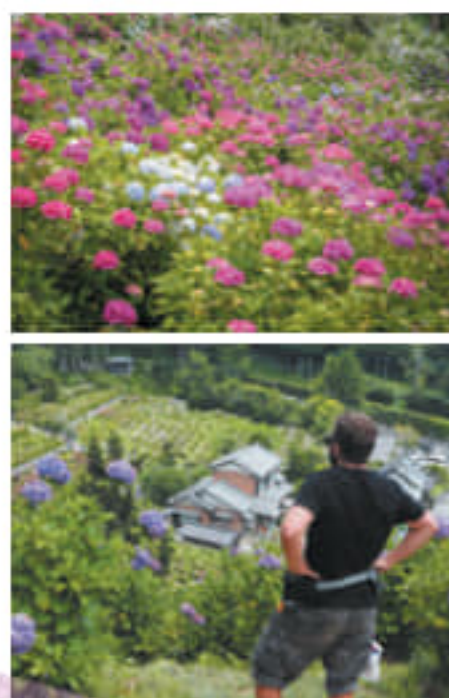
Katsuura Tantan ramen
